

Minutes of a Meeting of the International Association of Jewish Healers held on the 23rd October, 1967 at 323 Preston Road, Wembley, Middlesex.

Minutes: Mrs Martyn (founder) opened the Meeting and read the Minutes of the last Meeting held on the 24th September, 1967 in the absence of the Secretary.

These had been the first Minutes of the Association and a Committee comprising Mrs D. Martyn, Mr Sydney Lazrus, Mr G Cane-Treasurer, Mr G. Cane, Mrs A. Cane, Mr and Mrs Goldman, Mr and Mrs Brenner and four others was formed. Three vacancies were left on the Committee to co-opt Members at some later date who would be an asset to the Organisation.

It was decided that the Members' Fee should be £1.5.0 per person out of which an affiliation fee would have to be paid to the National Federation of Spiritual Healers which was a registered Charity. We would be obtaining all the benefits from that source and any guidance and help that we required.

Correspondence: Various letters were read coming from different parts of the country from interested persons all who thought the formation of an Association of Jewish Healers a very good idea.

Treasurers' Report The Treasurer reported that there was £27 in hand and the number of Members at the present time was twenty two, of who two were Honorary Members.

Pamphlet for Distribution to General Public: A draft of the pamphlet that it was proposed to distribute to Members and the general public was discussed. It was decided that the main points of the pamphlet should be as follows:-


- A. To unite Jewish Healers throughout the country.
- B. To eliminate fear and the spread of disease.
- C. To promote greater knowledge about the work of Spiritual Healing.

It was also decided that a flag should be made with the emblem of the Association embossed on it and that emblems for coats would also be made for the Healers to sew on their white jackets. The cost of these was being looked into and would be discussed at a further meeting.

News Letter: It was also decided that a News Letter would be commenced at a future date as soon as we would find an Editor and generally the News Letter would provide information about discussions on Healing, training of Healers and would give general information about the Association.

There being no further business the Meeting terminated with a vote of thanks to Mrs D. Martyn for her hospitality.
